● **BODY** language expert and author **Allan Pease**, who became an international star with his comical insights into human relationships, is selling a penthouse with uninterrupted ocean views.

Mr Pease, who wrote *The Definitive Book of Body Language*, which went to No. 1 on book-selling charts throughout the world, has put his apartment, near Mooloolaba on the Sunshine Coast, on the market.



The two-level apartment spread over 650sq m overlooks the town's harbour entrance and boasts 360-degree views.

Agent **Rob Keam**, of Ken Guy Real Estate, said he believed the property was in the most spectacular location in the area.

"It is on a stunning hilltop where the river meets the surf and the views are north to Noosa, south to Caloundra, west to the mountains and east over the beach to the Pacific Ocean," Mr Keam said.

The property's listing on the *Luxury Homes Australia* website says it is possible to look down on the coast from the rooftop spa and watch whales from bed.

The apartment, at 20/8 Pacific Blvd, Point Cartwright, Buddina, is expected to sell for about \$3.5 million.

Mr Pease and his wife, **Barbara**, have sold 21 million books, printed in 50 languages, in 130 countries.

Their most popular book, *Why Men Don't Listen and Women Can't Read Maps*, has sold 13 million copies.

The 10-bedroom mansion features a home theatre, tennis court, gym, swimming pool, spa and outdoor kitchen, along with views of Folsom Lake and a guest house.
